Why Study Child Development? - Online Learning

Recent studies suggest that catch-up growth is possible throughout early and late stages of childhood (3- 5) and that catch-up in physical growth is often accompanied by catch-up in other important child development and schooling outcomes (6- 10). However, most of these studies are limited to investigations of catch-up growth during early childhood, ie, ages ≤ 8 y, whereas evidence on the prevalence and consequences of growth faltering and catch-up growth in late childhood remains scarce.
