An applicant must answer 6 out of 10 questions correctly to pass the civics portion of the naturalization test.

## **Civics (History and Government) Questions for the ...**

Generally speaking, a person can become a U.S. citizen in one of four ways. First, by being born in the United States or one of its territories. Second, if you were born to parents who are U.S. citizens, then you may be a U.S. citizen yourself. This process is called "acquisition" of citizenship.
