SERVE, Clinical I, II, and III fieldwork opportunities all take place at a school site or facility with minors, therefore all students are required to obtain clearance from the Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) and provide a negative TB test result prior to placement. All students completing fieldwork associated with a CSULB course or credential program must have a valid Certificate of Clearance and TB Test prior to requesting a fieldwork placement with a partnering school district.

Office of Field Placement and Clinical Experiences

Students need to submit a pre-placement survey to the Clinical Coordinator by June 1 st for winter quarter fieldwork placement & Oct. 5 th for spring quarter fieldwork placement. If the survey is not completed on time, students will be assigned a fieldwork site at the discretion of the UWT faculty.
