Diagnostic Test Results Are Documented Code signs and symptoms if test results are unknown or return normal. If the diagnostic test did not provide a diagnosis or was normal, the interpreting physician should code the signs or symptoms that prompted the treating physician to order the test, Albert says.

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Diagnosis codes. Positive COVID. Assign code U07.1, COVID-19, for a confirmed diagnosis of the 2019 novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19) as documented by the provider, a positive COVID-19 test result or a presumptive positive COVID-19 test result. Confirmation does not require documentation of the type of test performed; the provider's documentation that the individual has COVID-19 is sufficient.

How to code for COVID-19 diagnosis, testing, telehealth ...

If you order diagnostic services for Medicare patients, you must also maintain documentation of the order or intent to order and medical necessity of the services in the patient's medical record. Keep this information available and submit it, along with the test results, upon request for a Medicare claim review.

(a) Ordering diagnostic tests. Except as otherwise provided in this section, all diagnostic x-ray tests, diagnostic laboratory tests, and other diagnostic tests must be ordered by the physician who is treating the beneficiary, that is, the physician who furnishes a consultation or treats a beneficiary for a specific medical problem and who uses the results in the management of the beneficiary ...

Adequate documentation is an essential part of selecting a correct code in any setting. When providers order a test, the information that they document regarding the test results determines the primary and secondary diagnosis codes a coder assigns. If a physician confirms a diagnosis based on the results of a diagnostic test, code that diagnosis. You may report the signs and symptoms that he or she used to order the test as additional diagnoses, but only under one of the following two ...

Diagnosis Coding with Diagnostic Testing - Find-A-Code ...

It is the physician's responsibility to document the patient's diagnoses. In the inpatient setting, a diagnosis based on an abnormal laboratory result or diagnostic test should not be determined by someone other than a physician. The physician must document the diagnosis in the medical record before it can be coded.
