SAMPLE CHICAGO PAPER (16th ed.) Chicago papers start with a title page. The title of the paper should be 1/3 of the way down. If there is a title and subtitle, the two should be on different lines, separated by a colon. About 2/3 of the way down the page should contain your name, the date, and any other information required by your instructor.

Double-space the text of the paper. Use left-justified text, which will have a ragged right edge. Do not use fully (newspaper-style) justified text. Use a 1/2" indent for paragraph beginnings, block quotes and hanging (bibliography) indents. Number the pages in the top right corner of the paper, beginning with the first page of text.

Use superscript format and start with the number 1.; Place the note number at the end of the clause or sentence that refers to the source and after all punctuation except for dashes (—).; The first time you cite a source, provide all information about it in the note: author's full name, title of the source, and publication ...
