The service must be: For the purpose of evaluating, diagnosing, or treating an illness, injury, disease, or its symptoms In accordance with the generally accepted standards of medical practice

A. Medical necessity is the overarching criterion for payment in addition to the individual requirements of a CPT code. It would not be medically necessary or appropriate to bill a higher level of evaluation and management (E/M) service when a lower level of service is warranted. Documentation should support the level of service reported.

Although a final definition and determination of "medical necessity" still is an unrealized goal of the medical, insurance, regulatory and legislative community, the American Medical Directors Association believes that the attending physician's decision and documentation should be held paramount.

Determination and Documentation of Medical Necessity in ...

- Furnished in a setting appropriate to the patient's medical needs and condition.
- Ordered and furnished by qualified personnel.
- One that meets, but does not exceed, the patient's medical needs.
- At least as beneficial as an existing and available medically appropriate alternative

There are three sets of requirements - general, financial and medical that are evaluated to make an eligibility determination for Medicaid. While there are requirements that are generally the same for each set of services, there are some differences - for example, an application for services under the Aid to the Needy Blind program requires an individual to have a medical necessity determination of legally blind.
