The citation information in the body of the paper itself is called the "in-text citation." The most obvious time to use it in the text is when you use a quote from a source directly or refer to it by title or author. Generally, you need to list the writer's last name and page number enclosed within parentheses straight after the quote.

When using APA format, follow the author-date method of in-text citation. This means that the author's last name and the year of publication for the source should appear in the text, for example, (Jones, 1998), and a complete reference should appear in the reference list at the end of the paper.

In-text citations: Author-page style MLA format follows the author-page method of in-text citation. This means that the author's last name and the page number (s) from which the quotation or paraphrase is taken must appear in the text, and a complete reference should appear on your Works Cited page.

Citation in the body of a research paper While writing body paragraphs, you should state the topic sentence, explain and support the main points and conclude the paragraph. It is a good idea to provide a citation while supporting the essential idea of the paragraph.

How to Do Citations in a Research Paper?

When you have an in-text citation of a print research report, include it on the Works Cited page. Begin with the last name of the author, a comma, first name and a period. Put the title of the article and a period inside quotation marks. Italicize the name of the journal.
