In the C: drive, double-click the Documents and Settings folder. In Documents and Settings, double-click the folder for the users My Documents you want to see. Using the same example as above, if your login is "John" you'd click the "John" folder. In your user's name folder open the My Documents folder.

Start page numbering later in your document - Office Support

To add page numbers to your Word document, switch over to the "Insert" tab on the Ribbon and then click the "Page Number" button in the "Header & Footer" section. A drop-down menu shows several different options for where you'd like the page numbers to appear—top of the page, bottom of the page, and so on.

How to Work with Page Numbers in Microsoft Word

Drag and drop your PDF into the PDF Splitter. Choose to 'Extract every page into a PDF' or 'Select pages to extract'. For the latter, select the pages you wish to extract. Click 'Split PDF', wait for the process to finish and download.

How to Delete Pages in Word [Both Unwanted and Blank Pages]

Select Insert > Page Number, and then choose the location and style you want. If you don't want a page number to appear on the first page, select Different First Page. If you want numbering to start with 1 on the second page, go to Page Number > Format Page Numbers, and set Start at to 0.
