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Intrinsic Motivation And Academic Achievement

Encouraging children's intrinsic motivation can help them to achieve academic success (adelman, 1978; adelman & taylor, 1986; gottfried, 1983, 1985). To help students with and without learning disabilities to develop academic intrinsic motivation, it is impoptant to define the factors that affect motivation (adelman & chaney, 1982; adelman & taylor, 1983).

Intrinsic Motivation and Academic Achievement: What Does ...

Academic intrinsic motivation has been found to be significantly correlated with academic achievement in students with learning disabilities (Gottfried, 1985) and without learning disabilities (Adelman, 1978; Adelman & Taylor, 1983).

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Intrinsic Motivation and Academic Achievement

Investigating the relationships between student's intrinsic (IM) and extrinsic motivation (EM) and their effects is critical for offering a more complex perspective on which types of motivation promote optimal learning and achievement. The goal of this study was to analyse IM and EM as two independent forms of motivation or, alternatively, as two opposite poles of a continuum ranging from a poor (extrinsic) to a good (intrinsic) form of motivation.

According to these studies, people with high achievement motivation are high academic achievers. They always set high levels of aspirations. Salami (2004) therefore reports that achievement motivation is a strong predictor of high academic performance and efficient schooling.

Relationship between Motivation and Achievement An emergent body of research shows great academic achievement with students who have higher academic motivation either due to intrinsic motivation or mastery orientation. The motivated students have better grade point averages, test scores as well as higher graduation rates (Alfaro, 2006).

Blumenfeld, Kempler and Krajcik (2006) argue that motivation alone is necessary but not sufficient for academic achievement. However, Hufton, Elliott and Illushin (2002) believe that high levels of engagement show high levels of motivation.

Test anxiety and intrinsic motivation were found to be significant mediators in the relationship between self-concept and academic achievement. In addition, intrinsic motivation significantly moderated the negative effect of test anxiety on academic achievement.

Based on the results of path analysis, the contribution of intrinsic motivation on learning achievement was $(0.359) \times 100\% = 29.05$ percent. These results illustrate that students with strong intrinsic motivation will acquire high academic achievement.
