During August, as the Battle of Britain became more fiercely joined, Bomber Command's effort against the German air force increased accordingly. Of the 2,227 sorties it flew in the month, 714 were against aerodromes in occupied Europe, almost twice as many as in July, and 435 against the German aircraft industry.

The AASF was formed on 24 August 1939 from the ten squadrons of Fairey Battle light bombers of 1 Group under the command of Air Vice-Marshal Patrick Playfair and was dispatched to airfields in the Rheims area on 2 September 1939. The AASF was answerable to the Air Ministry and independent of the British Expeditionary Force.

Air Force Completes 8-Year B-1 Bomber Battle Station Upgrade

A squadron of 12 aircraft was subdivided into sections of (at the time of Dunkirk/The Battle of Britain) three aircraft (the RAF later moved to four aircraft sections, as used by the Luftwaffe from the start of the war). Sections were a colour (usually Red, Yellow, Blue and Green), with the aircraft numbered 1, 2 and 3.
