Deciduous Shrub Pruning The correct time to prune shrubs is based on flowering habits. Shrubs produce flowers two ways. The first is referred to as "blooming on new growth" and the second is "blooms on old wood or growth". Non-flowering shrubs are treated the same way as shrubs that bloom on new growth.

Trees and shrubs may be lightly pruned year-round in Hawaii. Remove dead, broken, or diseased branches whenever they appear. Plants grown for foliage, such as podocarpus, privet, juniper, and yaupon holly, may be pruned at any time, because flowering is not important for these plants.

Pruning different types of plants requires different methods. Here are the steps to correctly pruning shrubs and trees around your yard: 1. Remove What is Dead or Dying. If you see branches which are already dead or are in the process of dying, you should cut those branches off first. Be sure to use a hand saw to remove thick branches.

When and How to Prune Trees, Shrubs, and Flowers Correctly

Pruning Fruit Trees If you are growing a tree for its fruit, make pruning a high priority. Heading cuts, or cutting the ends of branches, concentrate each branch's energy and encourage it to produce more fruit the following season. Thinning cuts, or removing entire limbs, allow you to take out unruly suckers and dead or diseased limbs.

How to Prune Trees and Plants - The Spruce

Prune these trees after they leaf out to reduce sap bleeding. Mid-March through mid-April: This is the ideal time to prune summer flowering shrubs. They bloom on new growth produced during the summer.

The first pruning after trees and shrubs are purchased consists of removing broken, crossing and pest-infested branches. The traditional recommendation of pruning up to one-third of top growth when transplanting to compensate for root loss is no longer valid, according to recent research.

Follow Proper Pruning Techniques | Earth-Kind® Landscaping

Most trees and shrubs with needlelike or scalelike foliage (spruce, juniper, cypress, arborvitae, fir, yew, Douglas fir, and false cypress) are best pruned early in the growing season. Avoid cutting back into wood that doesn't have any green needles; it may not sprout new growth.

What to Prune When | Better Homes & Gardens

Neglected, overgrown spring-flowering shrubs often require extensive pruning to rejuvenate or renew the plants. The best time to rejuvenate large, overgrown shrubs is late winter or early spring (March or early April). Heavy pruning in late winter or early spring will reduce or eliminate the flower display for 2 or 3 years.

Some common deciduous shrubs and trees used in Mississippi landscapes include forsythia, spiraea, weigela, lilac, rose, crape myrtle, quince, honeysuckle, hydrangea, oak, maple, and poplar. Deciduous shrubs may need pruning to control their size and shape. Light to moderate tip-pruning encourages thick new growth, resulting in bushy plants.

As a rule of thumb, prune spring-flowering shrubs and trees immediately after the flowers fade. Prune summer-blooming trees and shrubs in winter or early spring, before new growth emerges. In regions that have harsh winters, late-summer pruning encourages new growth that might not harden before the cold settles in.
