No rent increases or notices to increase rent through 10/15/20 (retroactive to 2/29/2020). Do not give notice of rent increase or offer renewal with rent increase, even if actual increase is set to take place after 10/15/20. No enforcement of rent payment if tenant was unable to occupy premises due to COVID-19 related circumstances.
