State authority means any organ of a State at each level of authority, whether the organ exercises legislative, executive, judicial or any other state functions, and including, without limitation, all central, regional, municipal, local and judicial organs or any consistent element of such organs having the power to govern, adjudicate, regulate, levy or collect taxes, duties or other charges, grant licences or permits or approvals or otherwise affect the rights and obligations of any Project ...

State authority | legal definition of State authority by ...

State authority means a public authority or public benefit corporation created by or existing under this chapter or any other law of the state of New York, with one or more of its members appointed by the governor or who serve as members by virtue of holding a civil office of the state, other than an interstate or international authority or public benefit corporation, including subsidiaries of such public authority or public benefit corporation.

State authority | legal definition of State authority by ...

The executive branch of government in each of the states is headed by the governor, who is elected by the citizens of each state and not subordinate to federal authority. As such, the governor is head of government, head of state, and commander-in-chief of the state's military forces (the National Guard).

Public authorities are corporate instruments of the State created by the Legislature to further public interests. Public authorities have various levels of autonomy from the State based on the powers, as well as the constraints, built into their legislative mandate.

A State Authority Code is a five digit number that uniquely identifies a State authority. This code is assigned by OSC. Each State authority that will submit contracts to OSC will be assigned a State Authority Code. Authorities that already have a code will maintain it for this purpose. This broad authority, which can be traced to English common law and is reserved to the states by the 10th Amendment, is far from radical; it justifies why states can regulate at all.

Yes, States and Local Governments Can Close Private ...

Authority does not equal coercion, A state's authority over people within its territory is based on the implicit threat of physical force (why do you follow laws?), But a state actually using physical force to get people within its territory to do what it wants—defined as coercion—becomes proof of the loss of its legitimate authority; although the state's authority derives from the implicit threat of physical force, resorting to coercion strips the state of all legitimate authority.
