On March 25, 1911, 146 people were killed in the Triangle Factory fire in New York City when fire broke out on the 8th floor of the building in which the factory was located. It quickly spread to the 9th and 10th floors also. People jumped from windows or were burned to death because of inadequate safety and escape mechanisms.

The Hess triangle is a triangular tile mosaic set in a sidewalk in New York City 's West Village neighborhood at the corner of Seventh Avenue and Christopher Street. The plaque reads "Property of the Hess Estate which has never been dedicated for public purposes." The plaque is an isosceles triangle, with a 25 1/2 -inch (65 cm) base and 27 1/2 -inch (70 cm) legs (sides).

the deadliest in U.S. history. The fire caused the deaths of 146 garment workers – 123 women and girls and 23 men – who died from the fire, smoke inhalation, or falling/jumping to their deaths.

But, New Yorkers gave this building a name of their own, the Flatiron Building, because of its similarity to the household appliance, a flat iron. With the intersection of Broadway and 5th Avenue forming a triangle, there was no room for a traditionally shaped building if the developer wanted to use all of the real estate available.
