As we were recently in the Isle of Wight, we went along to see what it was all about. The villa was originally discovered in 1879 when local children showed fragments of Roman pottery to retired army captain John Thorp.

Brading Roman Villa - Current Archaeology

In the villa's heyday the sea flowed round to Brading so it was a key port - Brading Haven eventually silted up and there is now marshland between Brading and Bembridge. With the decline of the Roman Empire in the 4th Century, the villa fell into ruin. For a time it was used as a barn, and an oven was built inside it.
