Transactional analysis is therefore concerned with (a) the diagnosis of the specific ego states involved when a person interacts and communicates with others, and (b) the way these states can lead to understanding or misunderstanding by the people involved in the transaction. Berne reports that patients can readily recognize the Parent, Adult, and Child components when clinical material is brought to their attention.
